Antepartum Fetal Assessment Education Course	1. Explain physiologic principles of maternal-fetal oxygenation as related to antenatal assessment of fetal well-being. 2. Compare the methods of antenatal testing, including analysis and interpretation. 3. Determine steps in the clinical plan of care based on antenatal testing results and interpretation.	Antepartum fetal assessment education course will provide nurses and clinicians working in the antepartum and ambulatory settings with a course that includes antenatal testing, creating a welcoming and inclusive clinical environment, and fetal monitoring interpretation. Course participants will gain an increased understanding of the physiologic principles of maternal-fetal oxygenation as related to antenatal assessment of fetal well-being. Using a case-based approach, participants will have the opportunity to determine the steps in the clinical plan of care and interpretation of fetal monitoring tracings.	1.0
