This education provides an evidence-based overview of fetal movement patterns across pregnancy and their significance in identifying potential fetal compromise. Learners will explore normal and abnormal fetal movement characteristics by trimester, associated risk factors, and the implications of both decreased and markedly increased fetal movement.
